

6 Endometrial stromal sarcoma**Micro**

- This is a myometrial fragment infiltrated by neoplastic irregular, jagged islands.
- The lesional cells are stromal cells admixed with prominent arterioles.
- Angiolymphatic invasion is evident.
- There is necrosis.
- The features are those of endometrial stromal sarcoma.

Diagnosis

- Endometrial stromal sarcoma

Further work/comment

- CD10, ER, PR and beta-catenin immunohistochemistry to confirm their diagnosis.
- Points that would be discussed at the gynaecology MDT:
 - The tumour's tendency to late abdominal recurrence but overall good prognosis despite recurrence.
 - The tumour's sensitivity to radiotherapy and endocrine therapy.
