Case 1 Pigmented lesion left neck. 27yr old male

- A section of skin shows a symmetrical benign junctional melanocytic lesion with sharp lateral and deep borders.
- Composed of pigmented monotonous spindled cells within the dermal papillae arranged perpendicular to the epidermis.
- No mitotic figures seen.

Diagnosis: Pigmented spindle cell naeavus/Pigmented naevus of Reed

Comment: Benign junctional naevus Correlate with age
