Case 11 Lesion right middle finger, right finger Bx 28yr male

- Section of skin shows an intravascular lesion with papillary formation and hyalinised cores lined by bland plump endothelial cells associated with an organising thrombus.
- There is no atypia or mitoses seen.

Diagnosis: Papillary intravascular endothelial hyperplasia

Comment

IHC: CD34 cells lining the papillae

Benign reactive lesion of vascular origin
