Case 17 Abnormality on CXR. Wedge resection of 30mm left lower lobe 56 yr male

- A section of lung shows a large necrotising granuloma with surrounding palisading histiocytes perpendicular to the necrobiotic centre.
- No carbon or silicon is seen in the necrotic area.
- Compressed surrounding lung parenchyma is seen with scattered nonspecific interstitial inflammation,
- No dysplasia or malignancy is seen.
- No vasculitis

Diagnosis: Rheumatoid nodule lung

Comment Exclude TB with ZN stain/PCR Exclude Wegener's granulomatosis After ruling out an infective process steroids can be administered Rheumatoid nodule assoc. with an increased serum Rheumatoid factor Assoc. with Joint disease
