

Case 17

Microscopy

sections show a well circumscribed nodular tumour located in the dermis containing of cells arranged in closely packed glands. The cells show eosinophilia to clear cytoplasm. lumen of few glands show eosinophilic secretion. There is no evidence of atypia, mitosis or necrosis. lymphovascular or perineural invasion is not identified. The overlying epidermis appears normal with no evidence of Paget's disease.

Diagnosis

The features are of lobular adenoma.

Clinical comment

- I will discuss the case in the Breast MDT and ask if the patient is lactating.
- I could spot myoepithelial cells in H&E but for completion I will request some basal and myoepithelial markers
- The lesion has favourable prognosis.

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
