sections show fibrocollagenous and fibromuscular tissue infiltrated by a tumour composed of cells arranged in glands and focally in nests. The nuclei show moderate nuclear pleomorphism. There is no necrosis, lymphovascular or perineural invasion identified. In addition the section also shows a lymph node showing direct infiltration by this tumour.
