### Microscopy

sections show normal ovarian parenchyma at one end of the specimen with a tumour at the other end comprising of cells arranged in glandular architecture with large areas of garland type necrosis. There is no lymphovascular or perineural invasion identified.

### Diagnosis

Metastatic adenocarcinoma of colocolic primary.

### Additional work up.

① The tumour cells will be positive for CK20, CDX2 and negative for CK7.
