METASTATIC ADENOCARCINOMA

Microscopy: Fragments of tissue lined by unremarkable squamous epithelium. The subepithelial tissue shows infiltration by tumor forming glands with prominent nucleoli in keeping with adenocarcinoma.

Diagnosis:

Adenocarcinoma.

Further work:

1. Immunohistochemistry
